The Italian Government is offering 9 monthly scholarships carrying an allowance of €900 each. The grants, which will be assigned for a period of study in Italy ranging from 3,6 or 9 months, are offered for the following type of courses: Master's Degrees courses, Ph.D. Courses, Research under academic supervision, Courses of Higher Education in Art, Music and Dance(AFAM) and courses of Italian language and Culture. Applicants are requested to fill in the appropriate online form on <https://studyinitaly.esteri.it/registrazione>. Only online applications through this system are considered.

All online applications must be submitted by **2 pm on May 30th 2019**.

A copy of the application must also be forwarded to the Scholarship Section of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and Trade Promotion. This can be submitted personally to the Scholarships Section or through the Scholarships website of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and Trade Promotion <https://foreignaffairs.gov.mt/en/Pages/Scholarships.aspx>.

Successful candidates may be required to enter into a contract to serve the Government or the Public Sector of Malta upon completion of the scholarship.

Applications from Government and Parastatal employees and from the Private Sector will not be considered unless recommended by their Head of Department/Employer respectively.

The Board's decision will be final.
